

Fr. Michael McGivney

August is an appropriate tome to remember our beloved founder, Fr. Michael McGivney. Fr. McGivney was born on August 12, 1852 in Waterbury, Connecticut; he died on August 14, 1890 (age 38) in Thomason, Connecticut.

Fr. McGivney he was ordained a priest on December 22, 1877. On March 29, 1882. While an assistant pastor at Saint Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut, he founded the Knights of Columbus with a small group of parishioners, as a mutual aid society to provide financial assistance, in the event of the men's deaths, to their widows and orphans.

In 1996, the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Hartford opened the cause for canonization, and on March 15, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI approved a decree declaring him "Venerable."
