
According to direction from Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, all meetings and functions of the Knights of Columbus are suspended until further notice in light of the current public health emergency.

## Resolution on an Emergency Expenditure April 2020

Whereas, we are being affected by the current COVID-19 Corona virus and are impacted by restrictive measures put in place to protect our own and the community health,

And Whereas, these restrictive measures have not only included Orders of the Governor of Virginia for people to stay in place but also to close all nonessential businesses.

And Whereas, these measures which are in place have affected the earning power of the citizens of the Commonwealth and subsequently caused many families to rely on assistance, particularly in the area of food supplies,

And Whereas, this reduction in income has in turn affected the financial support of those who contribute to food banks and other entities assisting families in need,

And Whereas, because of the current restrictions in place by Orders of the Governor, the Supreme Council, and the State Council have prohibited the Council from meeting this resolution is being submitted via email to the members for a vote for its adoption,

And Whereas, the Feeding Southwest Virginia is an established non-profit organization assisting local food pantries in their 26-county and 9-city area for delivery of food supplies to those families in need,

And Whereas, current restrictions in place by orders of the governor and the Knights of Columbus Supreme and Virginia State Councils prevent the membership of Roanoke Council 562 from meeting in person. **Be It Resolved** that Roanoke Council 562 adopt this resolution by email vote to issue a monetary donation to Feeding Southwest Virginia in the amount of \$1,500, thus providing 9,000 meals to those in need,

petitions, but deliver us always from all dangers, O glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen.




# Saint of the Month Athanasius of Alexandria

Athanasius was the 20th bishop and Patriarch of Alexandria intermittently from June 8, 328 to May2, 373. Athanasius was a Christian theologian, a Church Father, and a noted Egyptian leader of the fourth century. In 325, he served as a secretary during the <u>First Council of Nicaea</u>.

Athanasius is known as the chief defender of Trinitarianism against the heresy of Arianism (which did not recognize Jesus as wholly divine). In addition to his struggles with the Arians, he also had intermittent conflicts with several Roman emperors; he was exiled five times, when he was replaced on the order of Roman emperors.

Within a few years after his death, Gregory of Nazianzus called him the "Pillar of the Church". His writings were well regarded by all following Church fathers in the West and the East. He is remembered as one of the authors of the Nicene Creed and is the first person to identify the same 27 books of the New

Testament that are in use today.
Athanasius is counted as one of the four great Eastern Doctors of the Church. His feast day is celebrated on May 2.
