- Our council is needing program chairmen; contact DGK Clyde Moak.
- We are looking for a GoFundMe, an online auction, and fish fries in the fall to fund charitable contributions.
- The Grand Knight thanked Brother Knights and AOH members for work on the recent cleanup day at the council home.
- The proposed budget/spending plan was announced and approved with the following details:
 - 2-3 grants of \$500 for seminarians

Saint of the Month Gregory the Great, Pope

Gregory was born in 540 into a wealthy noble Roman family with close connections to the church. His father was a Roman Senator. His mother and two aunts were recognized as saints; his great, great grandfather had been Pope Felix III. Gregory was well educated in a wide variety of subjects, in keeping with his class.

In his early thirties, he held the title of Prefect of Rome. On his father's death in 574, Gregory converted his family villa into a monastery. Gregory had a deep respect for the monastic life and particularly the vow of poverty. After several years following the monastic life, Gregory was ordained. He served as a Papal Deacon, and Papal Nuncio to Constantinople from 579-85. He set out to evangelize England from 586-89. Gregory was elected pope on September 3, 590 upon the death of Pope Pelagius, and served until his death. on March 12, 604.

Gregory is credited with re-energizing the Church's missionary work among the non-Christian peoples of northern Europe, particularly the pagan Anglo-Saxons of England. He is recognized for reforming the liturgy (including the establishment of Gregorian Chant) and abolishing several clergical abuses. He is also remembered as a prolific writer.

Pope Gregory the Great died on March 12, 604 and was canonized on September 3, 604. He is recognized as one of the great Doctors of the Church. His feast day is September 3.



4th Degree to be Held in Virtual Format

The Virginia District Master has announced that the 31 October 2020 Exemplification will be held virtually, due to the COVID19 pandemic. The cost for the new candidates for the virtual exemplification is \$50.00 which will include a baldric, pin, certificate and the Supreme initiation fee. The candidate will be knighted by the Navigator or designated Knight at the first face to face assembly meeting that will be held after the exemplification. The Virginia Exemplification Team will hold this ceremony.

The ceremony will be held using the "Go to Meeting" platform, which has a 250 limit. A Knight will be able to come on individually or assemblies can form a small group in a single location to participate in the exemplification. With the 250 limit, candidates will have first preference and then observers.

The 31st of October is also scheduled for Fr. McGivney's Beatification Mass; this can be a day that can be remembered as candidates getting their 4th degree. Please consider this opportunity to avoid the normal time and expense to take the final step to Knighthood in our Order.



New Degree in Virtual Format

We are pleased to recognize those members of the Roanoke Council who have taken the Exemplification of Charity, Unity, and Fraternity to become 3rd Degree members of the Order. The combined degree will be available on demand from the Supreme Council for new members and those wishing to advance to full Knighthood in the Order. The Financial Secretary has been sending out information on taking the virtual degree, which takes 35-40 minutes from the comfort of your favorite chair at home. He will continue to send monthly reminders as the new procedure starting in September becomes available for distribution. Our Council will have its own team to perform the new combined degree when the current public health crisis has subsided.

Once again this year, the Virginia State Council is

holding a football pool with multiple weekly winners. Tickets are \$10 each or 3 for \$20. The council receives \$2 for each ticket sold, so be certain to include the council number with your ticket purchase. See details on the following two pages.



DIRECTIONS

- 1. MEMBERSHIP CARD COST BUY 2 GET 1 FREE: Membership Card is \$10.00. Purchase of the Membership Card automatically enters you into the Football Frenzy Game. By purchasing two membership cards you get a FREE ticket online! Free ticket(s) will be emailed to you, and automatically linked into your account (while supplies last, valid until 10/28/20.)
- 2. GREEN BEE SAVINGS CLUB: Go online to www.greenbeesavingsclub.com to take advantage of the Restaurant.com certificate offers. Your membership is valid online until 12/31/2020.
- 3. TEAMS: Football Frenzy tickets have 4 teams each week, and the 4 teams change weekly. No two tickets have the same 4 teams each week. Team codes are listed on the other side of the ticket.
- 4. DATES: Football Frenzy tickets are valid for the last 10 weeks of the Pro football season. Week #1 is November 1st. Week #2 is November 8th. Week #3 is November 15th, etc.
- 5. PRIZES: TOTAL PRIZES will be \$10,000! Prizes are awarded weekly to the ticket holders with the 4 teams that score the most or the least number of points. These 4-team totals are called the "Highest 4-Team Totals" and the "Lowest 4-Team Totals." The prizes for these winners are listed on the tickets. A total of \$1,000 will be paid to the ticket holders with the "Highest" and the "Lowest" 4-Team totals each week. In case of ties, prizes are combined and split. All results are final. ALTERNATE METHOD: In the unlikely event that any circumstances beyond our control make it impossible to determine winners as stated, an alternate method, the Weather Program, will be used to distribute prizes. Teams on all tickets will be considered "cities" as determined by Green Bee Fundraising. The "High" temperatures ("F) for the "cities" will be used instead of scores. The total sum in degrees for the "cities" will determine the High and Low winners. Go to www.footballsweeps.com for details.
- 6. WINNERS: Winning ticket numbers are posted weekly and are notified by mail. It makes no difference whether teams win or lose. In case of ties, prizes are combined and split. Winners do not need to claim a prize.
- 7. BYE WEEKS: The scores from the previous week's game will be used for teams that are not scheduled to play on any given week.
- 8. CHECK RESULTS: Winning ticket numbers will be posted weekly on Tuesdays, starting Tuesday, November 3rd. Go to the website listed below and click on the Football Frenzy Logo button to check results. Use your browser's address bar and not a search engine such as Yahoo or Google.




