Saint of the Month Juan Diego

Juan Diego was born near Mexico City in 1474. He was married, but had no children; little is known of his early life. When he was 50 years old, he and his wife converted to Christianity after its introduction to Mexico by Spanish missionaries.

Juan Diego experienced his first vision of the Virgin Mary on December 9, 1531. While on his way to mass, he was visited by Mary, who spoke to him in his native language and asked him to tell the bishop to build a shrine to her on Tepeyac Hill. The bishop did not immediately believe his story and asked for a sign.

On December 12, while searching for a priest to administer last rites to his uncle, Juan Diego was visited by Mary again. She instructed him to gather roses and take them to the bishop as a sign. She also informed Juan Diego that his uncle would recover from his illness. Juan Diego found many roses on the hill even though it was winter. When he opened his cloak while appearing before the bishop, dozens of roses fell out, and an image of Mary, imprinted on the inside of his cloak, became visible. Having received his proof, the bishop ordered that a church be built on Tepevac Hill in honor of the Virgin. Juan Diego returned home and found his uncle's health restored.

For the rest of his life Juan Diego lived in a hut next to the church built in honor of Mary and took care of the pilgrims who came to the shrine. He was buried in the church, and his cloak can still be seen in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The Basilica is now one of the most prominent pilgrimage destinations in the world.

Several other miracles are attributed to Juan

Diego. He was beatified on May 6, 1990, and canonized on July 31, 2002, by

Pope John Paul II. His Feast Day is December 9. He is the Patron Saint of indigenous peoples.

Through his intercession, grant the favor I now present (here make your request). Through Christ our Lord. Amen.



Exemplification of Charity Unity and Fraternity



Roanoke Council 562 hosted the virtual Exemplification of

Charity, Unity, and Fraternity on Monday, November 9 at OLN; the virtual exemplification was open to all Knights and candidates in the State of Virginia. Seventeen candidates participated in the exemplification statewide:

- 5 new members to the Order
- 3 online members who transitioned to council-based membership
- 9 current members who advanced to the Knighthood Degree, including George Clay and Travis Schmitt from Council 562

Statewide virtual exemplifications are held the second Monday of each month; we invite new members and current First and Second Degree members wishing to advance to the Third Degree to every exemplification. Current Third Degree members are welcome to register and observe the degree; candidates' friends and family are welcome to observe also.

The Financial Secretary will send out a link for registration for the exemplification. After completing the registration form, attendees will receive a link to the virtual exemplification.

We are offering these virtual exemplifications as an alternative to in person exemplifications because many councils are unable to conduct their own exemplifications due to COVID-19 restrictions. I hope that you will take advantage of this opportunity.
