In all, 42 candidates were advanced to the 4th Degree of our order; 17 candidates from Roanoke Assembly received the honors of the 4th Degree. Congratulations to those new Sir Knights, and especially to SK Rick Vitolo from Council 562.

SK Brian Ripple was recognized as the honoree of the degree. Brian has served Council 562 in numerous roles including current Financial Secretary of the Roanoke Council. He is a Past Grand Knight of Council 562 and Past Faithful Navigator of Roanoke Assembly 1167. Brian also served in multiple roles in the Virginia State Council, including State Deputy in 2020-21. If you are unable to help, please plan to attend the fish fry's and bring your friends.






## Saints of the Month Isidore of Seville

Isidore was born in 560 near Seville, Spain into a devout Christian family of high social rank. Two of his brothers were bishops and are also revered as Saints; one sister was an abbess and was also canonized. Isadore was a bright student and especially diligent in his studies at the Cathedral School of Seville.

It is unclear whether Isadore ever entered monastic life, but he held monks in high regard. In 600 he succeeded his brother Leander as Archbishop of Seville. As Archbishop, Isadore worked to convert the ruling Visigoths from the heresy of Arianism to orthodox Christianity.

Isadore was a lifelong learner and educator; he was widely recognized as a prolific writer. He was the first Christian writer to try to compile a summary of universal knowledge, in his most important work, the *Etymologiae*. This encyclopedia consisted of 448 chapters in 20 volumes. It was an important reference throughout Europe for over nine centuries. Archbishop Isadore presided over the Second Council of Seville (619), the Third Council of Seville (624), and the Fourth National Council of Toledo (633)

Isidore of Seville died on 4 April 636 after serving more than 32 years as archbishop of Seville. He was canonized by Pope Clement VIII in 1598 and declared Doctor of the Church in 1722 by Pope Innocent XIII. He is considered the last of the Western Church Fathers and "the last scholar of the ancient world". St. Isadore is the patron of students; his feast is April 4.
